

ST MARY MAGDALENE CHURCH PADDINGTON

This church is a fine Grade1 listed example of Gothic revival architecture, completed in 1873 and consecrated in 1878.

It was designed by GE Street at the height of his career, with his work and interest in the movement which revived the Gothic architecture of 1200-1500 using modern materials.

Medieval architecture was very colourful and full of symbolic details and St Mary's is the same with pointed arches leading the eye upwards and forms derived from nature.

We will have a guided heritage tour focusing on the gothic revival architecture, painted ceiling and stained glass.
